Dear Parents,

Discipleship Leading to Confirmation preparations are well underway. I am extremely excited that your youth is able to participate in our ministry for 6th-8th grade youth this year! This ministry is a three-year discipleship journey that culminates at the Confirmation Service. If you have a 6-8th grade youth that does not wish to be confirmed, they are still welcome to attend Ignite. At Grace, we are committed to becoming a family growing in Christ while reaching out in love. Our desire is to serve your family well through communication, prayer, and support. We want youth to know that their faith development is vitally important to their family, their church, and their God.

Ignite Youth Ministry: Ignite operates as a youth group with 30 minutes of large group teaching, 30 minutes of game time/free time, and 30 minutes of small group discussion. For those who do not receive day school instruction, attendance at Ignite is a requirement for confirmation. If students must miss Ignite, they are expected to watch the teaching video and fill out a note sheet for that week's lesson. However, you do not need to be getting confirmed at Grace to attend Ignite. Friends are always welcome! Those who attend classes in our day school are *highly* encouraged to be a part of the Ignite Sunday experience. They can attend the entire evening or they can come from 6:00-7:00 PM to receive the fellowship and small group experience they do not receive from the classroom. On weekends that we do not have Ignite, there will be an event for service or fellowship.

Expectations of Grace Lutheran Discipleship Leading to Confirmation Ministry

Please note, the following expectations are for all youth that wish to be confirmed at Grace Lutheran Ministries. All 6-8th graders are welcome to attend Ignite and youth events without the intention to be confirmed. We intentionally plan our evenings to be welcoming to all youth who wish to attend!

1. Discipleship Growth

A. Ignite Sundays: Education, Fellowship, and Discipleship

The scope and sequence will flow in yearly cycles:

Cycle A: The Plan of Salvation (Old & New Testament)

Cycle B: The Apostles' Creed, Sacraments, Discipleship Issues

Cycle C: Ten Commandments & Lord's Prayer (Cycle for 2025-2026)

Ignite takes place on most Sunday evenings from **5:30-7:00 PM**. In 30 minute intervals, we have a large group teaching (education), large group game/free time (fellowship), followed by small group discussion (discipleship). If students must miss Ignite, they are expected to watch the teaching video and fill out a note sheet for that week's lesson. GLS students can meet this requirement in their 8th grade confirmation class, but they are encouraged to come to Ignite for game/free time and small group discussion. That way, they receive the fellowship and discipleship they do not get in the classroom.

B. Fellowship & Service Events

Most months, we will have a large event that will take the place of our Sunday night gathering. We will rotate between an event focusing on fellowship and an event focusing on service. We ask that your youth do everything possible to attend these events as this is an essential part of their discipleship formation.

2. Worship Attendance & Sermon Notes

An important aspect of your youth's development is their time spent in worship where they can hear God's Word and receive His gifts. Youth must fill out a minimum of 20 sermon notes every year. Please keep track of your sermon notes. You can email info@grace-connect.org if you need an update.

3. Service Hours

Youth must complete a minimum of 10 hours of service every year. This service may NOT include doing service for your family, weekend serving responsibilities, or something the youth gets paid to do. This can include Ignite events and Vacation Bible School.

There is a service hour form that must be filled out each time your youth does an act of service in the community toward these 10 hours. Please keep track of your service hours. You can email info@grace-connect.org if you need an update.

4. Memory Work

Memory work is vital to the development of disciples as they learn the faith and the Word of God. Memory work will take place at the beginning of the large group teaching every week of Ignite and will be a “fill-in-the-blank” sheet of paper. The memory will be split between Luther’s Small Catechism and Scripture. GLS students can complete memory work at Ignite or in Confirmation class.

There are some who have problems with learning memory work. If this becomes an issue, please speak to Alex Cargin right away. We are willing to help work through this process to make sure that everyone has every chance to succeed.

5. Weekend Service Responsibilities

Service and involvement in our church body is a mark of discipleship for our youth. All 6th through 8th graders will be scheduled to serve according to the ministry they choose during registration. If no weekend service responsibility is chosen, students will be assigned to a ministry team. It is vital that you respond to service requests through Planning Center promptly, especially if your youth cannot make your scheduled date.

6. Communion

Communion is received by each youth after they have completed the communion class process, which will have its own registration and requirements. Each youth is required to go through this year-long process before they are confirmed.

7. Faith Testimony – 3rd Year Only

Youth will choose or receive a Bible verse to be blessed with during the Confirmation Service. This scripture verse will be used to write a faith testimony. More information on this faith testimony can be found in a separate document.

8. Confirmation Rehearsal, Pictures, Retreat, and Service - 3rd Year Only

The mandatory confirmation rehearsal, pictures, and retreat will be on May 2nd from 8:00-12:00 PM.

The confirmation service will be on May 3rd, 2025, at 1:30 pm.

9. Discipline Policy:

1st Offense: Verbal Warning

2nd Offense: Call Home Warning

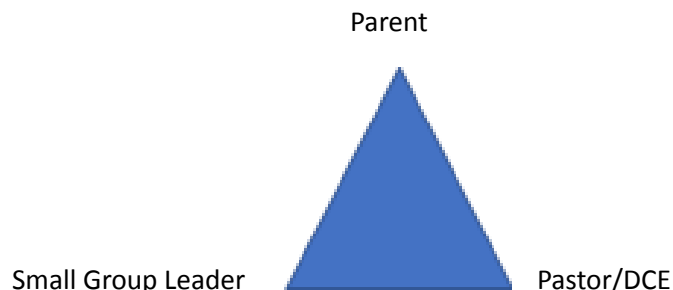
3rd Offense: Asked to Not Return for 2 Weeks

This discipleship ministry is about your youth’s continued growth, instruction, and discipleship. As such, involvement in every aspect of this ministry is a required component to participate in the confirmation service. Incomplete work will either be added to the following year or will delay the date of their confirmation. A youth’s readiness to confirm their faith will be determined by the youth, Pastor, DCE, small group leader, and parents.

Philosophy of Ministry

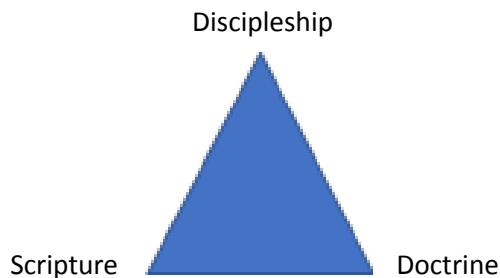
This ministry is and always has been about our youth's spiritual growth and walk with Christ. Foundational to this are Hebrews 5:11-6:3 and Matthew 28:18-20. We want to share with you what we see as the foundation of this discipleship ministry.

RELATIONSHIPS



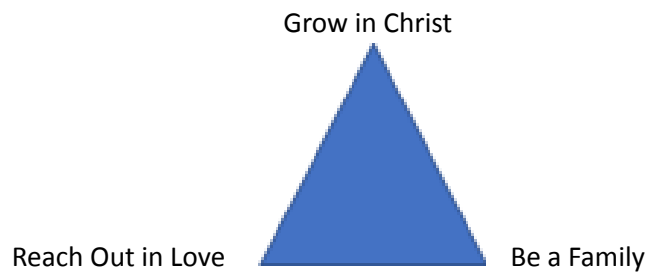
There are 3 key relationships that need to be present in the life of our youth as they grow spiritually: their parents, their pastor or DCE (Director of Christian Education), and another adult. The most important person that your youth can have a spiritual relationship with is you. We believe that parents have the primary role in the spiritual development of their child. This is an honorable calling, but a difficult one! We want to partner with you in doing this! The more you show your investment in your youth's spiritual growth the more *they* will invest in it. A church leader will invest in your youth's spiritual growth through teaching. Their small group leader, who is not a parent or pastor/DCE, will be that important third voice of encouragement, accountability, and engagement.

SPIRITUAL FORMATION



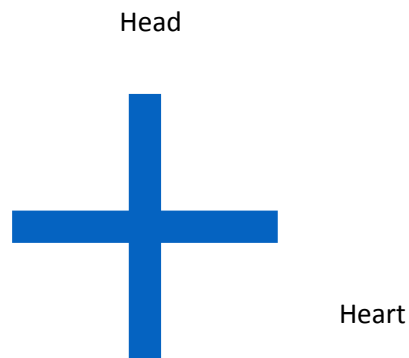
There are three key understandings that will be foundational to your youth's spiritual growth. Those are discipleship, doctrine, and Scripture. We will teach them to listen to the Scriptures as God's Word and understand what His Word means for their life. We will help them to understand from the Scriptures what we believe and why we believe it. This doctrinal teaching comes from a Christian worldview, instead of the secular humanist worldview. Finally, we will explore what it means to follow Christ, learn the marks of a disciple, and learn how to listen for God's voice.

DISCIPLESHIP DIMENSIONS



We believe that youth discipleship should be focused on growing in Christ, being a part of the family of God, and reaching out in love through witness and service. Because of this belief, throughout the year we will engage your youth in opportunities to live out their faith in all three dimensions. We will have discipleship events that focus on fellowship and fun with one another (Family) and other events that are focused on serving others (Reaching). During our discipleship class times, we will be spending time towards God and equipping them to pray and spend time in devotions on their own (Growing).

ENGAGE



In youth discipleship, we want to engage the head and the heart of your youth. Head without heart brings understanding of God and His will without application and experience. Heart without head allows for experience and application without Godly wisdom directing our experience. Discipleship seeks to combine increasing our knowledge and shaping our actions at the same time.

We want to invite your youth to bring their friends to youth events throughout this year to learn and grow as they do. We truly appreciate, enjoy, and look forward to the opportunity to come alongside your youth as they grow in their journey of faith. We are always seeking new and better ways to make this discipleship ministry more effective.
