

## LEAVE IT ALL ON EARTH TO FOLLOW JESUS!!




Only because it requires a new rhythm of life to bring about a healthy child. This is the same for church planting with one extra reality to factor in. 

## ON MISSION FOR JESUS

The heart beat of Endeavor Church is disciple making. We seek to reach the lost because we are compelled by compassion that is birthed out of disciple making. As we become more like Christ we overflow with His compassion that He has as he sees people. As we gather around in fellowship we get equipped for the days ahead so that as we go out, we go with the power of God who is at work within us.

Our method of disciple making is biblical and we do our best to reflect the way that Jesus made disciples. He spent intentional time together teaching and sharing life. Our team is growing spiritually because of discipleship and we believe that God is honored as we grow in Christ and in our relationship with one another.

The kingdom principle of multiplication is disciples making disciples that plant a church and then repeats is all over again. As of 2025 there is a projection that 15,000 churches will close their doors, that is 41



churches a day! We are only planting roughly 6,000 churches a year so that number does not add up. Take those numbers and consider the average church size in America is 60-70 people when it was 137 in 2000. The proper response to this is churches with the culture of Leave It All On Earth to follow Jesus Christ and plant churches.

Thank God Endeavor Church has answered that call and God will be glorified as we go!



C.T Studd wrote a poem and the words are still true today:


**“ONLY ONE LIFE TWILL SOON BE PAST,
