



### **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 1**

*"Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."*

*Matthew 22: 36-40*

Jesus made it clear that as his followers love Him with all they have, they will also have an increasing love for those around them. Spend some time intentionally praying this week that God will increase your love and compassion for others and also make you aware of ways that you can impact your neighbors in a tangible way for the Gospel.

### **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 2**

*"I will sing about the Lord's faithful love forever; I will proclaim Your faithfulness to all generations with my mouth." Psalm 89:1*

Learning to share God's love with others starts with recognizing God's love for you! As you pray for God to help you proclaim Jesus to the people you love, take time to thank God and worship Him for specific ways He has shown His faithful love to you. Next, pray for an opportunity to tell one of your God-stories!

### **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 3**

*"Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves."*

*Romans 12:10*

As we look around us and see our neighbors, help us to honor them by putting their needs as one of our priorities. God, keep our selfish interests and desires from being a hindrance to us focusing on being a friend and witness to others.

#### **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 4**

*"You answer us in righteousness, with awe-inspiring works, God of our salvation, the hope of all the ends of the earth and of the distant seas...Those who live far away are awed by Your signs..." Psalm 65:5, 8*

In the same way that no place is out of God's reach, no person is too far from the God of salvation. Pray today for God to reach the people in your life who seem spiritually distant with the joy and hope of salvation. Ask God how He might use you!

#### **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 5**

*"Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you." Colossians 3:13*

There will be times when relationships have the need for forgiveness. Remembering that God has forgiven us makes it easier to humble ourselves and forgive. Forgiveness allows a relationship to grow.

#### **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 6**

*"Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others." Philippians 2:3-4*

Spend some time praying this week that God will give you the awareness to overcome your selfishness and find ways to serve and love someone in ways that point them to the Gospel.

#### **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 7**

*"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:6-8*

It can be stressful and fearful sharing the Gospel with others and that's okay. Instead of hyper-focusing on the fear and stress, use that time and energy this week to pray and give your fear to the Lord and also spend some time thanking Him for who He is and what He has done in your life.

#### **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 8**

*"For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." Ephesians 2:10*

What an encouraging word! Not only has God created you but He has created you to do good works for His Kingdom! Pray that you would have the boldness and awareness of the good works around you that God has prepared you to be involved in.

## **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 9**

*"But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect..." 1 Peter 3:15*

As Christ-followers, we are commanded to be ready to give an answer for the hope we have in Jesus. Be ready to share your story because there are people around you who need the hope of the Gospel. As you pray this week, ask the Lord to give you an opportunity and the readiness to share the hope you have in Jesus with someone.

## **PRAYER PROMPT WEEK 10**

*"We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God." 2 Corinthians 5:20*

What a great privilege we have to be an Ambassador of the Gospel! God calls us to carry His story of redemption and love to those that who hopeless and searching for truth. This is a privilege, not a burden! This week as you pray, ask God to give you a willing and submissive spirit to carry the greatest message the world has ever known to those who need to hear it.
