THE LESSON AT A GLANCE

In today's text we examine the fifth of Jesus' "I am" statements with "I am the Resurrection and the Life." In addition to the seven statements, John also describes seven signs, or miracles, pointing to Christ's divinity. This passage is the last of those signs.

Next week we'll examine the Pharisees reaction to the raising of Lazarus. After chapter 11, the last ten chapters of John examine the final week of Jesus's earthly ministry, including His death, burial, and resurrection.

Here's a recap of John's seven signs:

- Turning water into wine (John 2)
- Healing the official's son (John 4)
- Healing the lame man (John 5)
- Feeding the 5,000 (John 6)
- Walking on water (John 6)
- Healing the blind man (John 9)
- Raising Lazarus (John 11)

THE MAIN IDEA

Jesus's miraculous resurrection of Lazarus from the dead foreshadowed Christ's death, burial, and resurrection and reminds us our eternal hope in Jesus.
