Dear Watchmen,

Part of Jesus' instruction regarding prayer in His most famous sermon is, **"When you pray, don't babble like the Gentiles, since they imagine they'll be heard for their many words. Don't be like them, because your Father knows the things you need before you ask Him."** Matt 6:7-8

Here are some needs that our staff wants you to bring to the Father this month:

Intercession: Pray for these...

3. To pave the path before us as we seek to build new infrastructure for families.

6. For the needs of the children that attend Thrive! for Kids and Students to be met. Ask that they feel seen, heard, and valued by the people they come in contact with as they practice the emotional management and self-leadership skills they learned during their time at TFK.
7. For bravery and resilience for those that are seeking to release the chains of hurts, habits, and hang-ups and are fearful to take the first steps through the doors of Celebrate Recovery.
8. For healing of those that are experiencing the dissolution of their marriages and are seeking recovery through DivorceCare.
9. For people grieving a loss, life change and/or challenges.
10. For single moms in our midst to feel love and a sense of community in their current circumstances.
11. For moms to find true, supportive Christian community in the monthly Mommy Matters group.
12. For Thrive! to “speak Jesus” into the hearts of all those with which we interact, endurance when the path gets difficult, for wisdom in urgent decisions, and for “next steps” to be made clear and the path to be bathed in His light.
13. To foster a spirit of excitement, commitment, joy, and deep learning among our Fall Women’s Bible & Book studies. Pray for the leaders, including our new team members experiencing their first semesters in women's classrooms, Lainey & Shelby (Thursday am), and Korinna (Wednesday pm).
14. Pray for our Mt. Pleasant women’s mission team who will spend Sept. 17-18 encouraging church plant wives/leaders and hosting a fall event for women at The Vine church.
